Installation Tips

Always use caution handling ABS or wheel sensor wiring. Avoid tension of any kind on wiring harness as this may cause damage or failure.

- 1. Trucks are often not level side to side from the factory. Please measure before installation.
- 2. Re-torque all hardware to manufactures specifications
- When aligning, to get the best tire wear use our supplied specifications. OEM specifications are for trucks with stock wheels and tires. Larger tires will wear differently.
- 4. All instructions are written with vehicle on a 2-post lift with tires removed.

Front Installation

Step 1

Remove axle nut at hub. Remove the three upper strut mounting nuts from under the hood of the truck. Protect the CV boot with a rag or similar to prevent damage to rubber boot. Use caution with any ABS wiring to prevent damage. Remove sway bar links from the truck. Remove lower strut mounting bolts

Step 2

Install**TRAXDA**spacer on the strut as shown in Figure A. Note the twisted shape of the**TRAXDA**cap, the strut base will need to be rotated 180 degrees before reinstalling in the truck.

Step 3

Reinstall the strut assembly. It may be necessary to use a pry bar to aid in the re-installation. Install the new TRAXDA sway bar links.

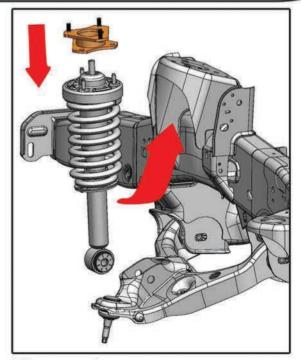


Figure A: Illustration is for reference only. Part dimensions will vary from kit to kit.

Rear Installation

Step 4

Use caution with any ABS wiring to prevent damage. Disconnect sway bar links, and loosen lower control arm bolts at frame. Remove bolt attaching lower arm to spindle. Remove lower strut mounting bolt and upper strut mount nuts and remove strut.

Step 5

Install **TRAXDA** spacer on the strut. Note the twisted shape of the **TRAXDA** cap, the strut will be rotated 180° when reinstalled. Reinstall the strut assembly in reverse of dis-assembly. A pry bar may aid in installation of the strut. Lower truck to the ground before tightening lower control arm to frame bolts. Verify that all hardware has been tightened to the proper torque specs.

Alignment notes:

We recommend that a technician with experience doing alignments on lifted trucks perform the alignment. Large tires wear differently than OEM sized tires. Always do an alignment after changing tires on a vehicle.
