## **Rear Installation**

405048 Chevrolet/GM 8-Lug Lift Kit

This kit contains:

- 2 Rear Block's
- 2 Center Pin's
- 4 Ubolts
- 1 HardwareInstructionsWarranty CardStickers



Disconnect any ABS or other wires so they can droop. Loosen lower shock bolt and remove. Use a jack to support the differential. Remove U-bolts from one side of the truck only, this will help keep the differential steady. Using C-clamps, as shown below, secure leaf springs and remove centering pin. Install Traxda block using the centering pin provided. Install supplied U-bolts, Re-connect lower shock. Repeat installation procedure on the other side of the truck.

## Torque U-bolt hardware to 75 ft. lbs. Never reuse U-bolts

## Alignment notes:

We recommend that a technician with experience doing alignments on lifted trucks perform the alignment. Large tires wear differently than OEM sized tires. Always do an alignment after changing tires on a vehicle.
